COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

ADA NSW will be conducting an Emerging Lecturer Competition at the ADA NSW Convention during 13 – 15 September 2018, to be held at the National Convention Centre Canberra.

PRIZES

The prize will be financial assistance of up to \$5,000 to attend a dental educational event of the winner's choosing.

Finalists will be provided with Day Only Registration but will not be reimbursed for expenses (e.g. travel and/or accommodation).

Entrants may be eligible to participate in the Australian Dental Association/Pierre Fauchard Academy's Emerging Young Lecturer Award intended to be held at the 38th Australian Dental Congress 2019.

CONTESTANTS

Contestants must be a member of the ADA, although not necessarily of the NSW Branch.

Contestants must have completed their most recent dental qualification within seven (7) years of the date of the competition ie: from September 2011 onwards. The most recent dental qualification may be either a primary or post-graduate dental degree.

PRESENTATIONS

Presentations must be in a digital format and will be for a total of 15 minutes; 12 minutes presentation and 3 minutes allocated for questions.

TOPICS

The topic is of the choice of the contestant but must be clinically relevant to dentistry.

REGISTRATION

Entrants must register an expression of interest using the ADA NSW link no later than Friday, 18 May 2018.

Abstracts must be forwarded using the ADA NSW link no later than Friday, 15 June 2018.

Entrants will be informed of the outcome of their entry no later than Friday, 20 July 2018.

LOCAL COMPETITION

If a large number of entrants register then a Local Competition may be used to select successful candidates for the final ADA NSW Emerging Lecturer Competition 2018.

JUDGING PANEL

The final judging for the ADA NSW Emerging Lecturer Competition 2018 will be three judges:

- President of ADA NSW or his/her representative
- Chair of Local Organising Committee or his/her representative
- An Academic or Training representative

JUDGING ASSESSMENT

The judges' assessment of the contestants will be based on a modified ADA Inc Emerging Young Lecturer Award 2017.

The Judging Panel will use a scoring system that will take into account the following:

VALUE OF THE PRESENTATION (CLINICAL/SCIENTIFIC CONTENT)

40 MARKS

- Originality of the material presented
- Relevance of the lecture to current concepts/themes
- Promotion of Australasian standards of dentistry
- Ability satisfactorily to answer questions from the panel/ audience

PERSONAL Demeanour

15 MARKS

- Use of appropriate language
- Appropriate attire
- Ability to maintain audience interest in the lecture
- Speaker's interest in the lecture topic

USE OF VOICE (SPEED AND DICTION)

20 MARKS

- Volume
- Speed
- Tone
- Flow of presentation

USE OF AUDIO-VISUAL AIDS AND TIME ALLOCATION

25 MARKS

- Ease of reading aids/presentation material
- Relevance of aids in the oral presentation
- Quality of clinical images and handouts
